

Am I Eligible for Damascus Strong Recovery Assistance?

You are eligible if:

- You have a Damascus address, or you own, rent or lease a home in Damascus.
- You can demonstrate financial need from storm-related expenses such as increased rent, loss of household items and personal belongings, repair costs, and/or loss of income.

Eligible expenses may include:

- Housing/rent/utilities
- Property damages or repairs not covered by FEMA or personal insurance
- Damages to critical infrastructure components such as septic tanks, furnaces, AC/HVAC systems, etc.
- Water damage, mold and mildew remediation
- Replacement household furnishings and personal belongings
- Computers & occupational tools not provided or supplied by an employer
- Transportation expenses
- Moving, storage, and/or clean-up expenses
- Assistance with food/groceries and/or emergency preparedness supplies

The Damascus Strong Recovery Assistance Application may be picked up from the temporary Damascus Town Hall during public hours on weekdays from 10am to 3pm (closed on Wednesdays). The print application is also available online at www.damascus.org/hurricane-helene.
